[The Homestead Crater](#)

Of all the unique and wonderful activities available in Park City, there is nothing quite like the Homestead Crater. It is a 55-foot tall, beehive-shaped limestone rock that nature has hollowed out and filled with 90–96-degree water. A tunnel through the rock wall at ground level leads to decks and a soaking area to access the crystal-clear mineral water. You can go swimming, scuba diving, snorkeling, paddle boarding or enjoy a therapeutic soak. The Crater is the only warm water scuba diving destination in the continental U.S.

- The cost of swimming or snorkeling is \$15 from Monday-Thursday and \$18 from Friday through Sunday and holidays for ages 8+
- For ages 3-7, the price is \$12 from Monday through Thursday and \$15 from Friday through Sunday and holidays.
- Ages 2 and under are free.
- Reservations are required.
- The minimum age for swimming is 5 years old.
- The minimum age for scuba diving is 12 years old.

Extreme Summer Tubing:

Take a ride down the landing hill of a Nordic Ski Jump – in an inner tube! Gain speeds up to 50 miles per hour and enjoy the thrill of soaring just like an Olympic Nordic ski jumper. (These are the same ski jumps that today's Olympic level athletes train on!) Extreme Tubing will take place on the Nordic Ski Jump – the K64 and K90 (larger hills) and K10 / 20 and K40 (small hills). The landing hill where your ride starts is constructed from a state-of-the-art plastic surface that slides just like snow when wet. Participants will be required to do the K64 before progressing to the K90.

[Alpine Slide](#)

The Alpine Slide is exactly what you'd expect from a place that built one of the most exciting Olympic sliding tracks in the world. The Alpine Slide is smooth, comfortable and offers amazing views of the Snyderville Basin. As for ride performance, the straightaways, drops, and 11 banked curves were designed to complement the scenic mountainside location. For added comfort, the easily controllable sleds allow riders — big and small — to go as fast or as slow as they want.

The Freestyle Zipline is a great way to warm up before stepping up to the Extreme Zipline. The Freestyle Zipline is a bit shorter, less steep, and totally fun. Perfect for younger kids or adults who want a more leisurely ride.
